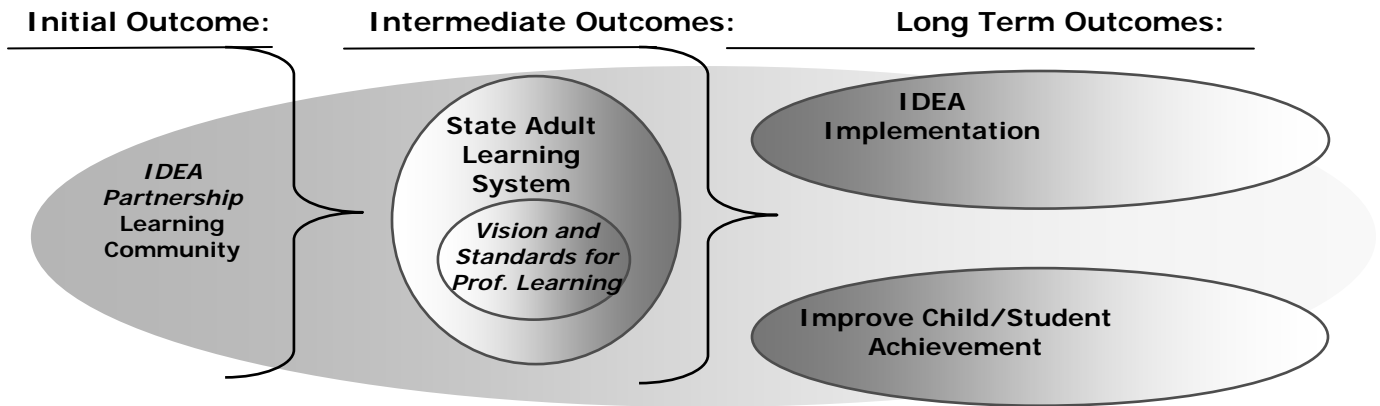


Michigan's IDEA Partnership's Logic Model¹



Partnership Purpose: *Help transform adult learning in Michigan to support implementation of IDEA and improve child/student achievement.*

Partnership Outcomes:

Initial Outcome:

- **Learning community:** Create a context that supports the development of a learning community with clarified structure, communication practices and commitments for purposeful integration of adult learning opportunities. *(focus of 10/29/04 Partnership meeting)*

Intermediate Outcomes *(focus of 1/25/05 Partnership meeting)*

- **State Adult Learning System:** Help transform the system into a more comprehensive, integrated adult learning system aligned with the State Board adopted *Vision and Standards for Professional Learning of Michigan Educators*.
- **PD Vision and Standards:** Promote quality adult learning practices aligned with the State Board adopted *Vision and Standards for Professional Learning of Michigan Educators* inclusive of ALL members of the educational community. *(Data-Driven and Evaluation standards were focus of 5/12/05 Partnership meeting)*

Long Term Outcomes:

- **IDEA implementation:** Improve the knowledge, skills and readiness among all partners to support IDEA implementation. *(focus of 1/25/05 Partnership meeting)*
- **Child/student achievement:** Increase child/student development {IDEIA 636 (d)}, academic achievement and functional performance {IDEIA 614(d)(1)(A)(i)(I)}.

2005-2006 IDEA Partnership Meetings:

- **November 17, 2005:** *All students are general education students first: adult learning strategies to support student progress.*
- **Spring, 2006:** *Continuing the work beyond the IDEA Partnership grant cycle*
